You cannot incorporate any extraneous information into your affidavit by reference; words like "incorporated herein" are not permissible, unless you identify the document as a numbered exhibit and attach the document to the affidavit as an exhibit. (Both affiants and the Judge will have to date and initial the exhibit, as well.) If you wish to refer to another document not attached, you MUST quote it exactly, surround the quoted text with quotation marks, and describe/identify the document quoted in your affidavit.

If both you and your co-affiant have statements in the affidavit, identify yourself as "I, Affiant [last name}," every time you refer yourself in the text of the affidavit, so your a/legation is attributable only to you.

The entire application and Search Warrant must be presented to the Prosecutor's Office BEFORE going to the judge.

DO NOT SIGN THE AFFIDAVIT BEFORE YOU GO TO THE JUDGE'S CHAMBERS. Both affiants are required to appear before the judge (in her/his chambers) and sign the warrant in her/his presence.

After everything is signed by the affiants and the Judge, the following procedures and timeline must be followed (for more info, please see Conn. Gen. Stat. §54-33c(c):

- After the Application and Warrant are signed, copy must be made and left with clerk's office;

- The search must be performed (i.e. executed) WITHIN TEN DAYS of signing and the original Application and Affidavit must be returned to the GA clerk's office for the court as quickly as is feasible

If no one is at the location when the search is conducted, leave the warrant conspicuously at the point of entry;
